

## 2008 Disaster Relief Report

Oklahoma Ice Storm –2007/2008. 15 volunteer days, 50 chainsaw jobs completed

Gulfport – 377 volunteer days, 1 salvation, 694 meals, 351 showers, 16 homes rebuilt

February 18 storm: Martin County wind event – 5 jobs, 4 volunteers; Greene County wind event – 5 jobs, 13 volunteers

Concord Apt. fire, Raleigh - shower unit, 6 volunteer days. No clients

May 8 Tornado (Davie, Forsyth, Guilford counties) 3 Assessment teams, 6 volunteer days.  
Guilford County tornado – 2 jobs, 11 vol's,

Mother's Day Tornado – (Bertie, Jones, Onslow) 2 Assessment Teams, 2 volunteer days; Bertie County tornado – 29 jobs, 50 volunteer days, 43 volunteers, 4 days

Myanmar Cyclone – ISR, 20 volunteer days, staged only, were not allowed into the country

Sri Lanka (tsunami) – 349 volunteer days

Macon, Georgia – tornado, 466 volunteer days, 7 salvations, 132 jobs completed

Sri Lanka flooding – financial assistance, \$5000, 500 meals. We start cooking in the morning and go out in a boat and give lunch to the people. We have set up a water filter system. So now we can supply good drinking water. Another \$3,500 sent July 2008. We worked on a few homes that had flood damage, did 3 health clinics. Had more then 400 people to come to them.
