

What to Bring FAQs

What forms do I need to turn in before camp week? All students and adult leaders must return the background check form and the mission preference form 4 weeks prior to camp.

What forms do I need to bring to check-in? Each group leader should bring 2 notarized copies of each participants medical form. One form will remain in the Deep Impact camp office and the other will stay with the group leader.

Do we need to bring linens? YES! Beds in all locations except DI Greensboro will be twin beds. Sleeping in Greensboro will be in a church and groups are encouraged to bring sleeping bags and/or air mattresses.

What general items to we need to bring? Bible, toiletries, towels, bug spray, sun screen, canteen money, offering, flashlight, pillow, and a good attitude.

Do we need to bring supplies? We do ask that each van be equipped with a first aid kit and that each church provide one cooler per van to carry lunches to the mission sites each day.

What items are not allowed at Deep Impact? Alcohol, tobacco, and illegal drugs of any kind are not allowed. Electronic devices are discouraged and are not allowed on the mission sites, in route to the mission sites or in worship.

What clothes do I need to bring? No cutoffs, ripped sleeves, shirts with offensive language, or tight knitted tank tops will be allowed. Shorts must be at least mid-thigh in length (most Softe style shorts are too short). A complete dress code is in the leader's packet.
