Why Caraway?

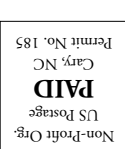
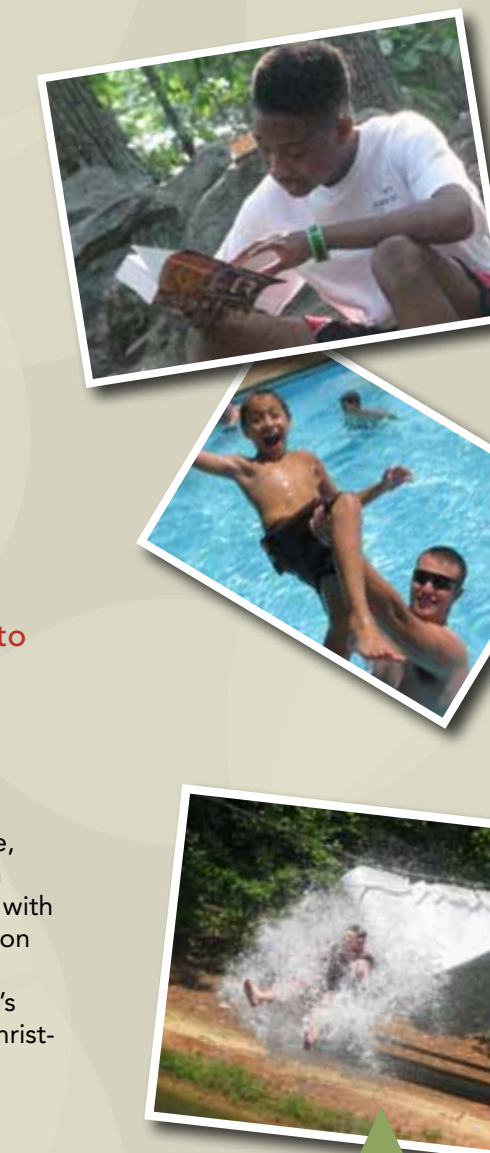
The Caraway experience is intentional about creating teachable moments through every aspect of camp. We use every activity, whether recreation or a worship service, to teach and equip young men with Biblical truths. Through our strong emphasis on relationships and community, our quality staff strives to build a positive relationship with each boy while modeling a godly lifestyle 24/7. At Caraway, our games and recreation support teamwork and individual growth. During our daily missions study, boys are challenged and given opportunities by seasoned missionaries to follow Jesus Christ's Great Commission. We also emphasize the importance of missions every day in a Christ-follower's life.

A typical day at Caraway begins with a camp wide morning stretch and our favorite song competition before breakfast. Quiet times are next, when we teach the boys to spend time with God in prayer and to read the Bible. After the cabins are clean we attend worship, when our camp pastor speaks and we worship through music. The campers are encouraged to understand and be involved in missions as they hear from our camp missionary. The rest of the day is busy with recreation, swimming, games, cookouts and campouts. Each year we introduce new games, skits, songs, and tweak many of our traditional recreations so they will still be exciting for returning campers. The camp canteen is open twice a day to purchase snacks, gifts, and the famous Caraway summer T-shirts. Before bed each camp counselor ends the day with an interactive Bible study.

Each age group is divided into different units. Each unit has a creative name that represents the geographic location of their cabin at camp. These unit names have been around since the beginning of camp, and each unit participates in graduated age appropriate recreation and activities.

Westwoods

For boys who have completed 3rd or 4th grade. This unit resides in the Westwoods Lodge. The cabin has four separate wings joined together by a large commons area. Westwoods Lodge is modern, air-conditioned and includes restrooms in each cabin. This unit is designed to meet the needs of younger boys and help them transition to a fun camp environment away from home. Our camp counselors can't wait to guide your son through new experiences that he will remember for a lifetime! Recreation includes: water fights, pedal race cars, crafts, low ropes challenge course, zip line, swimming in the lake, water slides, swimming pool, kayaks, archery, air rifles, sling shots, sports, cookouts, hiking, and more.

mountain view

For boys who have completed 4th or 5th grade. The Mountain View unit is separated into individual cabins that are air-conditioned and equipped with indoor restrooms. Recreation includes: overnight campout, swimming in the lake, water slides, swimming pool, kayaks, archery, air rifles, sling shots, sports, cookout, hiking, water fights, and more.

ROCKS

The young men of Rocks are ages 12-13. The Uwharrie Mountain breeze cools these summer cabins through their screened windows. The bath house is a short walk away. Recreation includes: paint ball, zip line, swimming in the lake, the blob, water slides, swimming pool, kayaks, archery with compound and recurve bows, air rifles, sports, campout, cookout, hiking, and more.

northwoods

The mighty men of Northwoods include ages 14-17 who camp in Caraway's three walled Adirondack cabins. Falling asleep with a campfire crackling nearby is normal in this rustic campsite designed to reach high school students by providing exciting recreation. Recreation includes: high ropes challenge course, climbing tower, 35' tall/300' long zip line, paint ball, the blob, water slides, swimming in the lake, dunking in the pool, pellet rifles, mountain biking, archery with compound bows, camping, cooking over fires, hiking, team sports, team building challenges, and more.

mini camp

We also offer a two-night camp experience for boys ages 7-9. This unique camp is customized to meet the needs of boys who are not ready for a week away from home. Recreation includes: water fights, swimming in the lake, water slides, swimming pool, crafts, kayaks, archery, air rifles, sling shots, sports, cookout, hiking, and more.

FATHER /SON CAMPS

This exciting camp is for any adult male mentor, father or grandfather to bring up to three boys who have completed kindergarten through 6th grade. One night and two night camps are available in the spring, summer, and fall. We want to give you free time to spend with your boys while still including organized camp recreation and programming. These camps include challenging Christian speakers, worship, skits, and recreation. Recreation may include: fishing, kayaking and canoeing, team building, swimming in the lake and pool, water slides (summer months), archery, air rifles, sling shots, sports, obstacle course, cookout, marshmallow roasts, hiking, and more. Father/son camps make a great birthday gift for a dad or a son.

CHRISTIAN HIGH ADVENTURE (CHA) expeditions

Christian High Adventure is the expedition ministry at Camp Caraway. This program is perfect for those who thirst for outdoor adventure, but have little opportunity to pursue adventure recreation. Our expeditions are designed for beginners to intermediate campers. We are intentional about using our expeditions to encourage people to have a deeper relationship with Jesus Christ and using creation to create teachable moments.



Anyone ages 14 and up is welcome. Participants must be physically capable of carrying a pack that weighs 30-40 pounds and able to paddle with no physical limitations. Trips are not designed to overwork participants, but some physical challenge is involved. Each trip is limited to 12 participants. All trips can be co-ed except for two male-only trips. To book a co-ed week a minimum of two females must sign up. Two college-aged CHA staffers of proven spiritual maturity and technical expertise lead each trip.

Whitewater expedition

Journey down the New River in West Virginia for an experience of a lifetime! Learn how to select and set up a campsite, use a cook stove, and many other aspects of camping as we camp near the river each night. Certified whitewater guides instruct and accompany us in our excursions down the river and elsewhere, experiencing the great outdoors that God has blessed us with. The trip may include learning to steer an inflatable duck kayak, learning to "read" the river, rafting with the group, team building, and swimming. On Thursday, we regroup with the rest of Camp Caraway and enjoy more fun times of camp life including games, swimming, and high ropes until time for pick-up on Friday.

CROSS COUNTRY EXPEDITION

The Cross Country Expedition offers you the opportunity to cross God's creation in several fun ways, including: mountain biking, rock climbing, rappelling, backpacking, and canoeing in North Carolina or Virginia. This week will introduce you to each recreation component as you camp out in creation. Each participant will learn the basics of each recreation activity and will learn how to select and set up a campsite, use a cook stove, and many other aspects of camping as we camp each night. No experience is necessary, as our trained guides will accommodate to your experience level. This expedition starts one day earlier than the whitewater expedition.



Retreats

Caraway is a great place to host your own camp or retreat from August through May. Churches and non-profit groups of all ages will enjoy our Christian hospitality and recreation. Many of the same recreational opportunities offered during summer camp are available throughout the year.
