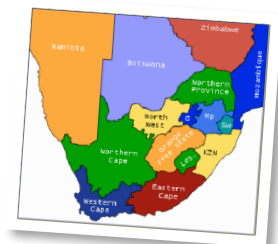
Africa for Christ Projects:

Church Planter Support:

The Financial Support for church planters will be for a four year period of time. We recommend that support start at \$400.00 per month for the first year and then be reduced by \$75.00 per month for each year thereafter. Year 1: \$400.00 Year 2: \$325.00 Year 3: \$250.00 Year 4: \$175.00 Year 5: \$100.00.

Church Planter & Emerging Leaders Training:

Director of Missions and Pastors wishing to assist in providing training can travel to South Africa and lead in training conferences with Church Planters and emerging leaders of the new churches. There is an annual national training held with the Baptist Union and church planters. Several times a year there are regional training events lead by Shadrack, the regional church planter consultant. Churches and associations can partner financially and by providing leadership to support these training opportunities.



Church Planter Introduction to church/association:

There is the possibility and perhaps the desire of the local sponsoring church and/or association to want to bring the church planter state-side to introduce him to the congregation sponsoring the new church plant in South Africa. This is not mandatory but it maybe something you wish.



Baptist Union Projects:

(There are other projects that may arise out of the partnership with Africa for Christ, which the Baptist Union of South Africa will assist in.)

Evangelistic Teams

A church or an association team may do a mission trip to assist the church planter and emerging leaders in doing evangelism within the community of the church plant. This might include personal evangelism, preaching revivals or outdoor campaigns, and other evangelistic projects.

Purchase of Church Property

Churches or associations may wish to assist the new church start in purchasing property for the first building site. This is not a requirement to participate in the Africa for Christ partnership, but some may desire to help. Monies for land purchase and all other projects will be sent to the Baptist Union and distributed by them.

Purchase of Tent or Materials to build a Shack Church

Once again, if a church or association wishes to participate in aiding in the purchase of a tent or materials for a shack church, they can through the Baptist Union.

Purchase of Materials for First Church Building:

Same with the assistance for the first church building.

Construction Teams to assist with First Church Building:

An association or church may desire to send a construction team to assist in the building of the first church structure. This will be coordinated through the Baptist Union of South Africa. Teams are responsible for their own travel and support.

Assistance with Economic Projects for Church Members:

There are also other projects that new church planters engage in to assist their members, especially in the poorer areas or South Africa. These are called "Special Economic Projects". These projects include things like: purchasing a sewing machine for a woman to make clothes to sell for her livelihood, purchase of chickens for egg laying enterprise, or many other projects.
