What the Bible Says:

Read: John 3:16

Let's talk about it:

There are a lot of ways to show love! There are many different people in the world and we do things in many different ways. What the Bible says:

Read: Hebrews 7:24-25

Let's Talk About it:

This passage tells us that Jesus is "alive forever". Before Jesus's sacrifice on the cross, a priest had to offer a sacrifice for the sins of people. But those priests were human and would eventually die and people are human and would continue to sin. So more and more sacrifices had to be made to reconcile humans to God. But when Jesus came, his death and resurrection paid it all...forever. He now lives and will never leave us. Now when we need to go to God for forgiveness we go through Jesus. This passage tells us that the way God saves is perfect and complete. So once we are saved through Jesus, it's forever. Jesus' sacrifice is POWERFUL! This passage also tells us that Jesus prays for us. When we trust in Jesus, He goes to God on our behalf. How AMAZING that Jesus loves us so much that He speaks to God for us!

What the Bible says:

Daniel 3:28-29

Let's talk about It:

The story of Shadrack, Meshach and Abednego in the fiery furnace is one of my favorites. If you don't know it well read all of Daniel 3 to get the details. But basically God's people were scattered and taken to a foreign land. Then they were ordered to bow down to a golden idol. This went directly against God's law. Many were scared and did it anyway because they were afraid not to. But these 3, (let's call them Shad, Mesh and Abed), refused! They said, no way, we can't do that. We only bow down to the one true God. Well, the king was so mad he threw them in an extra hot fiery furnace. They should have been killed instantly, BUT when the king looked in there were not 3 people but 4! And they were not burning up! He told them to come out and they didn't even smell of smoke! They were totally untouched by the fire. Because of this miracle and how God showed up in the furnace with them, the king made an order that no one was even allowed to speak against the God of Shad, Mesh, and Abed...the king said, "because no other God can save people THIS WAY". The faith of 3 young men and the faithfulness of our God changed the mind and heart of a terrible king.

What the Bible says:

John 13:4-5

Let's talk about it:

When we think about kings and royalty, we think about them having huge castles and lots of servants and not having to lift a finger. Jesus, God's son, king of the universe, is a very different king. We already read about how he gave his life for us, how he saves us, and how he loves and prays for us, now we read that he also serves us. This passage tells us how he got down on the floor and washed the dirty, stinky feet of his disciples. He could have ordered that they wash His feet, but he didn't, he could have insisted that they serve Him in this way, but He didn't. Our God is different in this way. Jesus is the Servant King and through His actions show us how to act towards others. No other god or king would consider washing someone's feet, no other king would lower themselves like this. He even served the ones that he knew would betray him. No other god or king loves and saves us the way Jesus does.
